

What if I accidentally sent Apple Pay?@request the money back

If you accidentally sent an Apple Pay payment to the wrong person, it's crucial to act quickly, as the transaction cannot be reversed by Apple. Once a payment is sent, it is final, and the funds are immediately available to the recipient.

Your only option is to **request the money back from the person you sent it to**. To do this:

1. Open the Messages app and go to the conversation with the person you accidentally sent the money to.
2. Tap the Apple Pay icon to open the payment screen.
3. Tap the "Request" option and enter the amount you want back.
4. Send the request.

If the recipient does not return the money, there is very little you or Apple can do, as the company states that it is not liable for payments sent to the wrong person.
